## Leaving a Legacy

As part of LDHL's mission to provide financial resources to Lancaster Country residents in support of their post-secondary education goals, we created Legacy Loans.

Legacy Loans, which are given in the same amount as Traditional Loans, are named after an individual, group or organization that has donated at the \$10,000 level, either as a one-time donation or over several years. The loan can also be named in honor of an individual, group or organization. Students can only receive a Legacy Loan one time, and the donor can set small preferences, such as specific major or specific school.

This year, we were fortunate to be able to give out a total of 30 Legacy Loans, up from 27 in 2019, thanks to the addition of three new Legacy Donors, who explain below why supporting LDHL's mission is so important to them. 
