

This issue of the Report Card showcases the many people who are integral to achieving the mission of Lancaster Dollars for Higher Learning. People often ask "How does it work to be able to give out interest-free loans, year after year?"

As illustrated below, it starts with students bound for higher learning (colleges, universities, trade/technical schools) who apply for interest-free loans. Where do the funds available for annual loans come from? The answer is simple: loan repayments from past loan recipients increased by generous donations from the community and businesses. With loans being distributed once a year, monthly loan repayments can be invested until it is time to send loan checks to schools in August.

While this cycle of applicants, loans, graduates and donors repeats annually, the work of the organization to achieve the mission would not be possible without the work of dedicated staff, Board leaders, community volunteers, generous donors, graduates in repayment and certainly current student loan recipients.

I am deeply indebted to each and every person included in this Report Card – it is you who achieve the mission, who make this organization successful and who make students' dreams of higher education become realities.



Achieving Mission Together





This year we were fortunate to be able to give out a total of 36 Legacy Loans thanks to the addition of three new Legacy Donors. They explain below why supporting LDHL's mission is so important to them.

Legacy Loans, which are given in the same amount as Traditional Loans, are named after an individual, group or organization that has donated at the \$10,000 level, either as a onetime donation or over several years. Students can only receive a Legacy Loan one time, and the donor can set small preferences, such as specific major or specific school.



"I'm grateful for what I have been able to achieve, which was only possible through the education that I received. I want others to have the same opportunity. Public service work is undervalued in the marketplace. Any assistance that encourages and allows people to pursue work in that area and have a livable wage and sustainable lifestyle is important. Although the loan amount was never very much but paying for school entirely on my own every little bit helped. After graduation I did volunteer, non-profit and government work so pay was limited.
